

Hershey-South PPL Transmission Line Project

SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

PPL Electric Utilities (PPL EU) plans to rebuild our existing 69kV transmission line between our Hershey Substation located on Route 422 and our South Hershey Substation located near Hershey Medical Center. Both substations are in Derry Township.

PPL EU amended our plans to rebuild the transmission line from aboveground to underground and are altering the route. Placement of the transmission line underground meets electrical reliability requirements of the project and resolves construction concerns we identified on the current right of way for the existing transmission line.

Construction of this line is required to reduce customer outages in the Hershey area and ensure long-term reliability and maintenance standards are met.

As a public utility and transmission owner we are responsible to provide safe, reliable power to our customers under various electric system conditions. Rebuilding of this transmission line supports this responsibility.

POWER LINE ROUTING AND CONSTRUCTION PROCESS

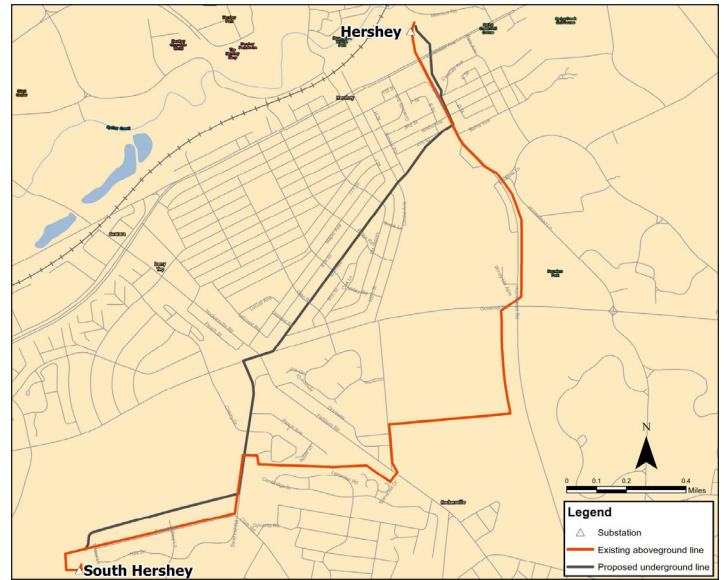
PPL EU and its contractors will be working as safely and as quickly as possible to complete this work.

Construction at this point is anticipated to take about 18 months, beginning midyear to fall of 2019. As we further develop this project exact dates and construction duration will be communicated to the residents and township.
