## Fence Ordinance

A. Fences erected on properties used in whole or in part for residential purposes may be erected to a maximum panel height of six (6) feet (72 inches), with the bottom of the fence panel not to be erected more than 4 inches above the surface or ground that supports the fence, subject to the following restrictions:

1. No fence shall be erected at such a location as to interfere with minimum sight distance specifications for street intersections and intersections of driveways and streets as established in Chapter 185, Subdivision and Land Development.
2. Fences of the type commonly identified as chain link fences shall be permitted only when the links, posts, and mounting fixtures are vinyl clad.
3. When erecting nonsymmetrical fences, the finished side of the fence shall be placed to the outside of the property on which the fence is located.
4. Fence posts, including any decorative finials or post caps shall not exceed more than 10 inches from the top of the fence panel that is 6 feet or greater.
