

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Derry, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, February 9, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. by audio and video conferencing via a Zoom Virtual Webinar, due to COVID-19. The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comment regarding Zoning Ordinance Amendment Petition No. 2020-01, as filed by Michele G. Buck. The petitioner requests that Chapter 225 (Zoning) of the Code of the Township of Derry be amended at Section 225-401.2.1 by permitting limited disturbance of slopes greater than 20 percent for residential structures, subject to certain standards and restrictions.
