## **Permit Application Checklist for Residential Dwellings**

	Signed and dated application with Sections I thru IV completed.
	<u>Three copies</u> of plumbing diagrams indicating, size, type, location of pipe and extent of work proposed.
	<u>Three copies</u> of mechanical drawings indicating all mechanical equipment, piping, ductwork, ductwork layout, heating and cooling load calculations, and extent of work proposed.
	<u>Three copies</u> of electrical drawings indicating all new and/or affected services, feeders, wiring sizes and methods, insulation types, conduit sizes and types, receptacle plans and lighting plans with circuitry, and extent of work proposed.
	Three copies of the drawings and specifications for the proposed work.
	<u>Three copies</u> of the plot plan delineating: the placing of the structure or addition, front, side, and rear setback lines, all impervious coverage. (Permit applications for new buildings, additions, detached structures, signs, and sheds require a plot plan.)
	<u>Proof of Worker's Compensation</u> coverage as follows – (Permits can not be issued without this coverage on file at the Township):
	If the contractor has employees, a Certificate of Insurance Form is required indicating that the coverage is current, containing an <u>original signature</u> from an authorized representative of the insurance company, and listing the Township of Derry, 600 Clearwater Road, Hershey, PA 17033, as Certificate Holder.
	If the contractor has no employees, a signed and notarized Exemption form is required. These forms are available in the Community Development Department at the Township office.
	No worker's compensation coverage is required if the registered homeowner is acting as his/her own contractor and is performing all of the proposed work.
	A portion of the building permit fee is required at the time of plan submission. Please contact us at 717-533-2057, Opt. 2, or <a href="mailto:commdevinfo@derrytownship.org">commdevinfo@derrytownship.org</a> for more information.
	If connecting to a public sewer, you must first obtain a sewage connection permit from the Derry Township Municipal Authority before a building permit can be issued.
NOTE:	<u>Applications for sign permits</u> : Please request the sign permit instruction information which details construction, material, color, size, etc.
NOTE:	If your property is subject to a Homeowners Association or other restrictive community requirement you may need to seek their approval.
