

## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-11

**A RESOLUTION** of the Township of Derry, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, to extend the flexible temporary plans, procedures, and guidelines as established in Resolution No. 2020-15 to assist local businesses in responsibly reopening and resuming operations as they recover from the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic crisis.

**WHEREAS**, on June 9, 2020, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Derry adopted Resolution No. 2020-15 to institute strategic measures in support of the Township's business community to operate safely and in a manner designed to prevent a resurgence of the virus while respecting and following the Commonwealth's restrictions; and,

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2020-15 was termed to remain effective for 60 days from the date of adoption and was scheduled to expire on August 8, 2020; and,

**WHEREAS**, on July 28, 2020, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Derry adopted Resolution No. 2020-17 to extend the strategic measures in support of the Township's business community to operate safely and in a manner designed to prevent a resurgence of the virus while respecting and following the Commonwealth's restrictions; and,

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2020-17 was termed to remain effective for 60 days from the date of adoption and was scheduled to expire on October 7, 2020; and,

**WHEREAS**, on September 22, 2020, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Derry adopted Resolution No. 2020-28 to extend the strategic measures in support of the Township's business community to operate safely and in a manner designed to prevent a resurgence of the virus while respecting and following the Commonwealth's restrictions; and,

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2020-28 was termed to remain effective for 60 days from the date of adoption and was scheduled to expire on December 6, 2020; and,

**WHEREAS**, on November 24, 2020, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Derry adopted Resolution No. 2020-35 to extend the strategic measures in support of the Township's business community to operate safely and in a manner designed to prevent a resurgence of the virus while respecting and following the Commonwealth's restrictions; and,

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2020-35 was termed to remain effective for 60 days from the date of adoption and was scheduled to expire on February 4, 2021; and,

**WHEREAS**, on January 26, 2021, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Derry adopted Resolution No. 2021-08 to extend the strategic measures in support of the Township's business community to operate safely and in a manner designed to prevent a resurgence of the virus while respecting and following the Commonwealth's restrictions; and,

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2021-08 was termed to remain effective for 90 days from the date of adoption and was scheduled to expire on May 5, 2021; and,

**WHEREAS**, the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic crisis continue throughout the Commonwealth, Dauphin County, and the Township of Derry; and,

**WHEREAS**, Governor Wolf's Proclamation of Disaster Emergency is still in effect; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires to extend the effective date of Resolution No. 2020-15 for an additional 90 days, ending August 3, 2021 or until such time as the Township repeals Resolution No. 2020-15.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Derry, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, that Resolution No. 2020-15, *Derry Township COVID-19 Recovery Flexible Business Support Program Guidelines*, and its authorization and temporary suspension of the enforcement of certain Township Ordinances shall expire 420 days after its effective date, or once repealed by the Township Board of Supervisors, whichever first occurs.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall become effective immediately.
