INTRODUCTION:

Solicitor Armstrong opened the public hearing and reminded the Board that there was a public hearing on this matter at the last meeting. He stated there was an issue with the advertising of the hearing because it was only advertised once and needed to be advertised twice. In accordance with the MPC and Township zoning, this hearing has been advertised correctly.

He noted this hearing is for a rezone the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania property for the State Police. It is a proposed changing of the zoning classification for a portion of the land identified as Dauphin County Tax Parcel No. 24-004-013, totaling approximately 42 acres located north of Hersheypark Drive and south of Police Academy Drive. The owner of the property has petitioned the Township to rezone the property. The Dauphin and Township Planning Commissions have reviewed and provided recommendations. He noted the counsel for the Commonwealth is here tonight. He asked the Board if they had any questions for him and there were no questions asked.

Solicitor Armstrong asked Mr. Narkiewicz, counsel for the Commonwealth, if he wanted to address the Board. Mr. Narkiewicz stated they acquired lots from the Hershey Trust to expand the Police Academy. He stated this request was to have all the lots zoned the same way for the campus. He showed the Board the two brown areas on the map that they are asking to be rezoned.

He again asked the Board if they had questions, and they had no questions. He stated this hearing could be closed and it was on the agenda for action at tonight's regular meeting.
