Upon hire, officers must complete a minimum one-year probationary training period.

Applications must be accompanied with a resume, notarized Personal Inquiry Waiver, Consent Form and Medical Release form which can be uploaded to the *PoliceApp.com* or presented at the time of testing. No written recommendations or other training certificates will be accepted at this time.

Written Examination and PAT

Physical Agility Testing will start promptly on **Saturday, February 25th, 2023, at 8:30 a.m.** at the Milton Hershey School – Catherine Hall located at 300 Hotel Road, Hershey. Applicants should arrive at 8:00 a.m. to register.

Written examination will be administered to those who successfully pass the Physical Agility Testing (PAT) on the same date following the PAT. Further instructions will follow.

Preferential scoring points will be awarded to applicants based upon Act 120 certification, honorable military service and educational achievements.

Finalists will be required to undergo a thorough background investigation, psychological and medical testing, oral interview and a polygraph examination.
