**INTRODUCTION:**

Vice Chairwoman Nutt stated this is a Public Hearing regarding a request from First Watch Restaurants, Inc., for the approval of an intermunicipal transfer of Liquor License No. R-11632 from Steelton Borough to 151 West Chocolate Avenue, Suite 143, Hershey, Derry Township. She turned the Hearing over to Solicitor Armstrong. Solicitor Armstrong stated this meeting has been advertised as required and opened the Hearing. He noted Act 121 of 2000 requires a municipality resolution approving an intermunicipal transfer of liquor licenses.

Mr. Rick Conicelli, Director of First Watch Restaurant Group, stated the liquor license would compliment their restaurant. He noted their restaurant serves breakfast and lunch. There are 500 other restaurants operating in 28 states and 70% of them have a liquor license. Solicitor Armstrong asked about the hours of operations. Mr. Conicelli stated they operate from 7 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. daily. Vice Chairwoman Nutt asked about checking ID for serving alcohol. Mr. Conicelli stated the employees are RAMP certified and all the drinks are made in the kitchen because there is no bar in the restaurant. There were no public comments offered. Solicitor Armstrong closed the Hearing and stated the Board could approve the resolution for allowing the transfer of the license.

Vice Chairwoman Nutt made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2023-08 to approve the transfer of a restaurant Liquor License No. R-11632 into the Township of Derry. Supervisor Wyckoff seconded the motion. **Motion carried 4-0.**
