#### **INTRODUCTION:**

Chairman Abruzzo stated this is the reconvened public hearing regarding Conditional Use Application No. 2022-06 (Plat 1359), as filed by equitable owner Linlo Governor Crossing, LLC and Sheetz, Inc., regarding a Master Plan Development. He asked that everyone identify themselves when they speak at the podium. He turned the meeting over to Solicitor Nelson. Solicitor Nelson had no administrative items to discuss.

Attorney Jamie Strong asked Mr. Christopher Commarata, VP of Construction with Kiddie Academy, questions about his background and the potential Kiddie Academy site.

Township Attorney Scott MacNair asked Mr. Commarata questions.

Attorney Crist asked Mr. Commarata questions.

Attorney Getz asked Mr. Commarata questions. Attorney Strong objected during the line of questioning about Hope Road since it is not part of the plan. Solicitor Nelson asked him to reword the question and upheld the objection related to the question of fairness. Attorney Getz continued to ask questions after the objection.

Attorney Greenberg asked Mr. Commarata questions. During the business model questions, Attorney Strong objected as it has nothing to do with the Township's ordinances. Attorney Greenberg noted he is trying to establish who will control the Center. Solicitor Nelson overruled the objection. Attorney Greenberg continued his questioning. Attorney Strong objected to the relevance of the questions and stated the Township can restrict the hours and the applicant would be bound by those restrictions and spoke about the conditional use. Solicitor Nelson overruled his objection based on his comments on the first objection. Attorney Greenberg continued his questioning.

Attorney Winter asked questions of Mr. Commarata. Attorney Strong objected to the question of why this was a good location. Solicitor Nelson asked him to reword the question and move on. Attorney Winter continued his questioning.

Ms. Annette Means asked Mr. Commarata questions.

Ms. Newman had no questions.

Mr. Doug Miller asked Mr. Commarata questions.

Mr. Hitchcock had no questions.

Vice Chairwoman Nutt, Chairman Abruzzo and Solicitor Nelson asked questions of Mr. Commarata.

#### **RECESS & RECONVENMENT**

The public hearing recessed for a break at 7:42 p.m. The hearing was reconvened at 7:58 p.m.

Solicitor Nelson asked if Attorney Strong had called his last witness and he stated he did and asked that Applicant Exhibits A1-A30 be entered into the record. Attorney Strong also asked that he be allowed rebuttal as the hearing continues. Solicitor Nelson asked the parties if there were any objections. Attorney Crist suggested that the applicant may want to only enter the most recent traffic study and Solicitor Nelson stated it is best to enter everything. Solicitor Nelson indicated it was time for Township Attorney MacNair to call witnesses.

Township Attorney MacNair provided a handout of exhibits to the Board and the parties in attendance. He called Mr. Eric Stumpf, HRG Engineer and Township Engineer to be sworn in. Stenographer Miller swore in Mr. Stumpf. He asked Mr. Stumpf about his education and work experience. He provided Exhibit T1 which was Mr. Stumpf's resume. He moved that Mr. Stumpf qualified as a Traffic Engineer. Solicitor Nelson asked if there were any objections and there were no questions or objections by the parties in attendance. He continued to ask Mr. Stumpf questions.
